- Records (including application forms) of any visa and permit you currently hold
- Records of any previous and current sponsors you have had
- Records of any previous deportations or removals from the Cook Islands
- Information held by Immigration that may have been provided about you by police or law enforcement in the Cook Islands or overseas.

None of this information will be provided to the employer, internship provider or education provider.
