

## Public Notice – COOK ISLANDS PERMANENT RESIDENCE

The Principal Immigration Officer hereby issues the following notice (3/3):

### Liability for revocation of permanent residency status

This notice is to advise that the following persons appear to meet the criteria for the revocation of their permanent residence status.

### Grounds for revocation

I have determined that you may be liable for the revocation of your permanent residence status under section 51 of the Cook Islands Immigration Act 2021, which states:

*The Minister may revoke a person's permanent residence status (other than permanent residence by descent) if the person has been outside the Cook Islands continuously for more than 3 years and the Minister is satisfied that the person has ceased to make their home in the Cook Islands.*

### Procedural requirements before Minister revokes permanent residence status

Cook Islands Immigration Regulations 2023

Regulation 34 -

(1) Before recommending to the Minister that a person's permanent residence status should be revoked under section 51 of the Act, the principal immigration officer must—

(a) contact the person directly and invite them to provide any information to show that their permanent residence status should not be revoked because the criteria in section 51 have not been met; or

**(b) if the person cannot reasonably be contacted directly, publish a notice of the intended revocation that names the person and invites them to provide the information described in paragraph (a).**

(2) A notice under subclause (1)(b) must be published—

(a) in a newspaper circulating in the Cook Islands at least 3 times within a period of 20 working days; and

(b) by at least 1 other method that is readily accessible by the public (for example on an Internet site maintained by or on behalf of the Department).
